### [OSLIS How Do I Begin?](#)

1. Two ways to search for information on the Web are shown at the OSLIS site. A \_\_\_\_\_ search looks for all sources that contain your search words.
2. A \_\_\_\_\_ search looks for major headings that contain your search words.

### [OSLIS Boolean Operators](#)

3. Three operators (words) can be used in a Boolean search. The three words we use are \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. It is a good habit to type these words in uppercase letters.
4. Using \_\_\_\_\_ between two search words makes your search smaller.
5. Using \_\_\_\_\_ between two search words makes your search larger.
6. Using \_\_\_\_\_ between two search words finds only the first search word.

7. When typing search words they \_\_\_\_\_ be spelled correctly.

### [OSLIS Quotation Marks](#)

8. A \_\_\_\_\_ is created when you put keywords inside quotation marks.

### [OSLIS Truncation](#)

9. Truncation means to "\_\_\_\_\_". An asterisk (\*) is usually used at the end of a word when using truncation.

10. A \_\_\_\_\_ is used to leave out a letter in the middle of a word. A question mark (?) is usually used.
